YASASVI Entrance Test 2022 was conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) on 25.09.2022 for selection of eligible Other Backward Classes(OBCs)/Denotified Tribes(DNT)/Economically Backward Classes(EBC) candidates for award of scholarships to students studying in Class IX and Class XI of specified schools under the PM Young Achievers Scholarship Award Scheme for Vibrant India (YASASVI) of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MSJ&E), Govt. of India

It was conducted in the Computer Based Test(CBT) mode at 110 centres, located in 79 Cities across India.

Post exam, question paper, responses of the candidates and provisional answer keys were hosted on the NTA website during 5-7 October 2022 and candidates were given an opportunity to challenge the answer keys. Challenges received were got verified by experts and the results were processed on the basis of the answer keys so finalised.
